NATIONAL SECURITY CHALLENGES AND NATIONAL SECURITY SERVICES

The Hungarian Association for Military Science, the Commission for Military Science of the Hungarian Academy of Science, the National University of Public Service and the Association of Reconnaissance Society in series of conferences on the military science in our days organised a conference at the National University of Public Service with the title: National security challenges and national security services. Since the political transformation but in particular since 9/11 the national security services face with numerous challenges mainly transnational, but domestic as well. The CXXV/1995 law on national security is no more suitable for the challenges therefore it would be justified to create a new law. The current four national security services in our country work under the direction of three different institutions, there is a lot of parallelism, and little coordination. All this manifest in the tasking and in the fusion of the reports at government level. These facts motivated the conference and determined the topics. The topics of the conference were divided in three panels, the first one deals with the challenges, the second with the answers to the challenges and the third with the security services. In all panels the domestic representative of the profession, heads of the security services gave lectures and the audience contributed with questions and remarks to the success of the conference. In this issue of the journal *Hadtudomány* (Military Science) we intend to provide our honoured readers with the shortened version of these lectures.

Szabó, Miklós: RAPID DEVELOPMENT OF THE MILITARY SCIENCE IN THE PEOPLE'S ARMY OF HUNGARY, ADDITIONALLY ON THE ZRÍNYI MIKLÓS MILITARY ACADEMY, IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE 1970s
